In all C.A.S.S. accommodation each resident has their own room which can be locked. In some areas there are self-contained flats and in others there are communal areas which are accessible to all residents such as the kitchen and bathroom. - We want to do a health and safety check on the property (we are required to do this every month and we would write in advance to tell you when we would be coming)
- If there is an emergency repair required (eg. water leak into room below)
- If we have concerns for your safety or have had no contact with you for some time
- If the police require access and they have a warrant.
